Q6. What is your stance on protecting productive horticultural land from urban sprawl and subdivision?

Tasman district is best served by maintaining distinct villages and communities with good infrastructure and connecting roads. I support further intensification in existing residential zones before farmland is considered for development.

Q7. How will you improve rural road infrastructure to support the movement of produce?

Roading is core infrastructure. I support continued maintenance of these assets.

Q8. What policies will you support to help growers adapt to climate change impacts?

There are so many potential impacts (hail storms, flooding, droughts) that it is difficult to imagine a set of policies that would offer support across all eventualities. A fiscally strong council will be in the best position to offer support when or if required.
